We are pleased to offer what is probably the largest working reference library of books about Gypsies remaining in private hands – almost 400 items running to about 500 volumes, for sale as a collection.

The collection reflects the previous owner's interest in Asia and is particularly rich in linguistic research, tracing the origins of the Romany language in India through their movements in Eastern Europe, up to the present day in Britain and the United States.

Many books concern folklore and history, including a number of foreign language publications, and many of the items are of the utmost rarity, including several that I have never handled before.

Many items are association copies, some including letters or interesting inscriptions, and many were formerly owned by important scholars or luminaries in the Gypsy Lore Society, which is itself represented by a complete run of its august journal – often found in parts on the market but rarely complete.

We have priced the books individually for guidance, but we feel the library should be offered as a whole, thus affording the opportunity to purchase a near complete working library en bloc.

The retail prices we have quoted total some £37,000 but we are offering the whole collection for a discounted price of £30,000. There is no VAT or any other tax involved, and shipping costs can be discussed. Deferred billing can be arranged for libraries if required.
